LVIV stalked the pace from the rail, waited for room at the three-eighths pole, angled out for the drive and finished well to be going away at the line. HAVE THE LAST WORD reserved off the early pace, circled three wide in the turn to a striking position, angled out to the six path and closed with a rush to be up for the place. EXECUTIVE BARLEE pressed the leaders from three wide, challenged for the lead at the eighth pole and hung in the final sixteenth. PRO GOLD sped off to take command leaving the chute, remained on the front-end under pressure to the final sixteenth and weakened in a game effort. VI'S VILLIAN saved ground down the backside and through the turn chasing the leaders from the rail and made a mild bid through the lane. DREAMBOAT CHARLIE pressed the early pace from between horses to mid-turn, dropped back from contention and finished evenly. A ZOO SOCIETY raced evenly without impact. UP TO MY ELBOWS prominently placed early in striking position, faded at the quarter pole. FREEKIN proved to be no threat. PROCACITY was never a factor.
