JOSE SEA VIEW raced up the rail to take command leaving the chute, set a pressured pace the entire trip and drew away inside the final eighth. READY FOR ACTION reserved off the early pace to the quarter pole, cut the corner and rallied well up the rail to gain the place. BRAYS SECRET away alertly to take the lead, settled to press three wide leaving the chute, loomed boldly in mid-stretch and weakened inside the sixteenth pole. SPRINGS R LOADED stalked the pace to the top of the lane and lacked a response late in the lane. TUSCAN GETAWAY pressed the pace from between horses to upper stretch and gradually faded back in the stretch. CROWDED HOUR raced evenly failing to threaten. NEEDMORE FLATTERY broke sharply and dropped back to trail throughout.
