UNHEDGED saved ground, bid inside at the quarter pole and was clear, then lasted under a steady drive. TINY BEAR was off awkwardly, stalked the pace between foes, was bumped at the top of the stretch, ducked inside, then rallied late and missed. EDDINGTON'S NOTE stalked the pace three wide, bid at the quarter pole, was bumped at the top of the stretch, bid but had no late gain. WILD FOR LOVE angled seven wide at the top of the stretch, then bid belatedly. FRANKS OFFICER GAL saved ground, rallied at the quarter pole, then faltered. FUNFAIR pressed the pace outside of the leader, then gave way in the drive. MISO BAD stalked the pace four wide, then lacked a late bid. JUST GOT IN led inside, then gave way in the drive.
