THEMANMYTHNLEGEND stalked the pace four wide, bid and was clear late under a mild drive. LAST EMPIRE pressed the pace three wide before giving way late. TWO TAVERNS rallied belatedly five wide. AUSTONS SURE CURE hopped at the start, then had a mild late bid between rivals. BAYSTONE was off awkwardly, led inside, then was steadied at the eighth pole and lost momentum. HISTORICALLY pressed the pace four wide to the stretch, then gave way. HEYWOODS saved ground and faded on the far turn. OMINOUS SKY was bumped at the start, stalked the early pace between rivals and then gave way. DENALI BIRDSTONE pressed the pace for a half mile between rivals, gave way and was eased.
