EYE OF THE EAGLE saved ground, angled out four wide at the eighth pole, rallied and was up late under a strong drive. SCULPTOR stalked the pace three wide, bid at the quarter pole and was clear late, but couldn't hold off the winner. BOLD RED bid four wide at the quarter pole and then hung. CREDIT REPORT dueled outside of a foe, but gave way late. MAKE MY DAY bid six wide at the quarter pole before faltering in the drive. GIBSON dueled inside, then gave way in the drive. HALF A WELL stalked the pace four wide, then faded in the drive. C B THE DEPUTY was not a factor. VALTER showed nothing.
