RUBY JANES GIRL prompted the pace three wide under confident rating, moved to a short lead after a half mile, was set down leaving the three sixteenths marker, opened up a clear lead and was kept to a drive. WARISON chased the pace off the rail, circled four wide into the stretch and finished willingly. BUT MOMMY , forwardly placed along the rail nearing the turn, was put to strong urging mid turn, angled wide and offered a mild response. TIS CAFE RISQUE lodged a two wide bid between rivals into the turn, dueled into the stretch then gave way nearing the furlong marker. DENIM WILDCAT cleared early and angled to the rail, dueled mid turn, remained a presence to the quarter pole and weakened. MISS PROSPECT saved ground mid way on the turn, angled wide and failed to respond.
