WESTERN INFLUENCE rated kindly while saving ground, angled out advancing leaving the far turn, rallied four wide to command in upper stretch, kicked clear in mid stretch, responded solid handling and dug in to prevail. MACHO CHICK settled well off the rail, lost ground five wide when starting a run after a half mile, continued well wide into the stretch, drifted out late and finished gamely to be gaining. SHANGHAI KNIGHT settled in mid pack while off the rail,

came four wide for the drive and finished willingly to earn the show. SLICK VIC , four wide the first turn, tracked the pace, moved three wide in hand to take command around the far turn, edged clear leaving the three eighths pole, was collared in upper stretch and weakened late. HERR MOZART , in close soon after the break, was taken to rate while saving ground off the pace, steadied when shut off with run past three sixteenths marker, altered out wide in the final furlong and continued on with interest. WILD AND WILEY , unhurried early, raced between rivals mid way on the final turn, shifted in near the three sixteenths pole but failed to generate the needed rally. BLOOD MOON saved ground under rating, moved closer near the quarter pole, angled three wide but came up empty. B FOR BEEZ cleared early, set the pace off the rail, was overtaken into the far turn, chased, gave way and steadied near mid stretch. SOLDIER FIELD stalked the pace three wide, raced four wide between foes into the far turn and weakened. KID KEARNY GABE pressed the early pace and tired. OUR BAILIWICK , sluggish early, raced five wide near the quarter pole and failed to menace. FUNNY BOOK was outrun.
