**Footnotes**

DELICATE GENIUS set the pace near the rail, maintained a clear advantage throughout, drifted out approaching the eighth pole, lugged in near the sixteenth pole and was kept under pressure in the drive. EMERALD SONG , three wide the first turn, saved ground the far turn, eased out in upper stretch, altered course to the inside of the winner approaching the eighth pole then flattened out. DAYDREAMIN GRACIE , along the rail entering the far turn, worked between horses in upper stretch, angled out near the sixteenth pole and passed tired foes. RHETORICALQUESTION , between horses on the far turn, entered the stretch in the three path, had aim on the lead in midstretch then weakened. GREAT MOTION , inside horses in the stretch, passed tired ones. ANN MILLER , between horses in the stretch, passed faders. LILY OF JOHAR , wide leaving the far turn, gave way late. CONGAREE PRINCESS , inside horses, chased the pace to the stretch then gave way. VICTORIA'S STRIKE was outrun. PEDROIA , very wide entering the stretch, was outrun. A NEW DAWN , outside horses, chased the pace to the far turn then faltered. GRANT PARK , wide the first turn, dropped back. An objection by the rider of EMERALD SONG against the winner for alleged interference in the stretch was not allowed.
