D DAY , brushed at the break, settled off of a contested pace while four wide near the half mile marker, dropped in for the run around the final turn, gained momentum inside past the five sixteenths marker, swung back out four wide entering the lane, forged past the leaders inside the three sixteenths pole and steadily kicked away under a drive. GRANDILOQUENT settled back early, saved ground under a ride leaving the three eighths pole, angled out nearing the furlong marker and closed between rivals to gain the place in the final seventy yards. AMELIA'S BRIO lacked speed, circled five wide advancing into the stretch, made steady progress past the furlong marker, continued willingly but was outfinished for the place. SECRET PEACE grabbed command into the first turn, was confronted by LILY QUATORZE into the backstretch, was overtaken near the five eighths pole, dueled inside that rival, regained command in upper stretch but could not sustain and weakened in the final sixteenth. LILY QUATORZE leaned in at the break and brushed with TREZ, was straightened away and moved up four wide into the first turn, bid to challenge entering the backstretch, put a head in front five furlongs out, dueled on a short lead to the head of the lane, held well to the three sixteenths pole then faded. TREZ , brushed at the break, forced the early pace three wide then was rated back off the top pair in early backstretch, tracked the duel, was asked for run leaving the far turn, failed to solidly respond, chased the leaders to the head of the lane then gave way. PRINCESS MALKA , fractious in the gate, hopped up as the gates opened, dwelt to be off well behind the field and trailed.
