Footnotes

BOOT THE BOSS , brushed with COOPER COUNTY down the backstretch, angled in nearing the turn, made steady progress along the rail past the five sixteenths marker, angled out for the drive, collared BIG GRANDPA, inside the furlong marker, dueled outside that one, gained a slim advantage near the sixteenth pole and held sway under right handed encouragement. BIG GRANDPA broke a step slow, quickly recovered and sprinted inside rivals to go clear in the opening furlong, set the pace off the rail, drifted out some nearing the quarter pole, entered the lane two wide, was taken on past the furlong ground, dueled inside the winner through the final sixteenth and stayed on gamely. SOUTHERN RAINBOW , sluggish leaving the gate, was taken to rate off the pace while saving ground, angled out in upper stretch, worked between rivals inside the sixteenth pole and had a belated gain under hand urging. SIN AND THE CITY forced the pace in the three path, was put to solid pressure mid turn, could not go with the leader and weakened in the final quarter mile. COOPER COUNTY , brushed early, raced wide and had no rally. HALTON , away in good order, forced the issue four wide and dropped back leaving the three sixteenths marker.
