VALAY BULLET quickly went clear and secured the inside, dueled with MZ. ANN from the three furlong marker to the wire and narrowly proved best under a stiff drive. MZ. ANN advanced four wide near the half mile pole, lodged a three wide bid leaving the turn, dueled with the winner, put a head in front in mid stretch, battled gamely and just missed. SAM'S SUNNY HALO, close up early while three wide, dropped back on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and closed willingly. PALETTE KNIFE vied between rivals into the turn, rated back on the turn, stalked the pace behind the top pair into the stretch and lacked the needed stretch response. ARCILLA moved closer four wide into the stretch but lacked a further response.
