### Footnotes

MAGICAL RUN gained command soon after the break, set a pressured early pace two wide under a light hold, moved clear around the turn, dropped to the rail in upper stretch, kicked away when roused left handed in mid stretch then held safe under a steady left hand drive. FRANKIE SAYS RELAX prompted the winner three wide, was put to a solid ride mid turn, chased the winner into the stretch and continued on gamely to be clear of the place. GRAND SAM was lightly steadied leaving the five eighths pole, settled into stride soon after, steadily advanced along the rail into the stretch and continued on with interest. DUG BAR lacked speed three wide, angled in around the turn and lacked a late response. YOUR BUSTED chased the pace while saving ground, angled out mid turn, came three wide for the drive and gave way. DA POLONIA, washy and fractious in the post parade, lost ground three to four wide, failed to keep pace and dropped back around the turn. RAGING WILD FIRE had a four to six wide trip chasing the pace and gave way. GHOSTOFACHARLIE, between rivals early, chased the early pace off the rail, came four wide for the drive and faltered.
