WILDCAT APPEAL saved ground, set a pressured pace, remained on her left lead in the stretch, drifted out a bit near the sixteenth pole and lasted under brisk urging. SEEYOUINTHETOWN circled the turn three deep, was fanned to the four path in upper stretch and rallied. SHEZA CLASSY LADY broke sluggishly, was four deep on the turn and found her best stride late to close the gap outside horses. STAR HOLIDAY saved ground on the turn, eased out to the three path in upper stretch and lacked the needed late response between rivals. MAID FOR JOE prompted the pace outside the winner and tired. QUEEN OF THE DISCO, in close quarters leaving the starting gate, raced along the rail down the backstretch and was outrun.
