### Footnotes

MALVERN ROSE broke sharply, was well rated setting the pace towards the inside, edged away in mid stretch then held sway under a drive. KISS A MISS broke a step slow, quickly reached contention towards the inside, stalked the pace in the two path on the turn, angled in near mid stretch and finished gamely to earn the place. RADIANCE (VEN) prompted the pace outside of the winner, was put to urging near the quarter pole then faded in the final eighth of a mile. CRAFTY GETAWAY lacked speed, saved ground into the lane but lacked a solid response. AMBER COMET raced between rivals into the stretch and did not factor. BERNIE'S GOLD chased the pace while three to four wide throughout and weakened. ORIENTA, taken to rate, steadied a bit nearing the turn and weakened.
