Footnotes

OBAN rated close up while off the rail, moved between rivals leaving the far turn, chased the leaders into the lane, shifted out four to five wide, closed steadily under left handed pressure, collared CHICKEN PICKER a sixteenth out then forged away in the final yards. CHICKEN PICKER stalked the pace three wide, moved to engage the leader entering the far turn, dueled into the stretch, took a short lead past the three sixteenths marker, edged away slightly inside the eighth pole, was joined a sixteenth out and gave way grudgingly. UNCLE TODD , bumped with LITTLE GRANDPA at the break, cleared early, set a slow pace in about the two path, took pressure into the far turn, dueled inside CHICKEN PICKER from the quarter pole to mid stretch, drifted out and weakened. BLADING SILVER , wide and between rivals, angled in leaving the three eighths pole, made a slight run near mid stretch then flattened out. ROYAL LOUIE lost ground four wide, made a mild run into the far turn then faded. SKIDOODLE lacked speed, was used up five wide when moving from the five eighths pole to the far turn. SHARP START saved ground tracking the early pace, was asked for run near the far turn, failed to respond and dropped back. LITTLE GRANDPA , bumped at the break, lagged back along the inside early and failed to fire.
