MARA QUEEN broke alertly, set a rated pace along the inside, was briefly headed after a half mile, quickly regained command, moved clear in upper stretch and dug in gamely under pressure. TULEYRIES rated close up, advanced three wide between rivals into the lane, lodged a bid outside of the winner leaving the sixteenth pole then hung. MYTHICAL BROWNIE lost ground four wide throughout, moved to a menacing position leaving the three furlong marker but came up empty in the stretch drive. VICTORY PROSPECT raced under rating to the five sixteenths marker then failed to respond. RICH HAPPINESS prompted the pace three wide, briefly put a head in front down the backstretch, continued to force the issue into the lane, tired and was not abused in the final furlong. PARALINK disputed the pace between rivals and tired nearing the quarter pole.
