Footnotes

AVENUESOFNEWYORK moved up four wide in hand to join the fray after a quarter mile, launched a bid past the three eighths pole, dueled outside rivals, drifted out a bit entering the lane, was corrected soon after, forged clear in mid stretch and edged away under a drive. AWAKEN SPIRIT , forwardly placed off the rail, was steadied off heels entering the turn, regrouped to advance between rivals approaching the stretch, gained some near the furlong marker, flattened out a bit late but held the place. KID KNOCKOUT , taken to rate early, gained ground five wide approaching the lane, sustained his run past the furlong marker then flattened out under hand urging. THIRD N THIRTEENTH angled off the rail entering the turn, came four to five wide for the drive but failed to generate the needed response. TEN MISSIONS saved ground under early rating, made some progress along the rail near mid stretch, shifted out but came up empty. TARGET THE GOLD lacked speed, came five wide for the drive and had some belated interest. DISTINCTLY DONOVAN vied between rivals early, dueled inside foes holding a short lead approaching the stretch, held well to the eighth pole then weakened. APRIL'S FOIL , between horses early, moved to within striking distance of the duel mid turn, failed to kick on when set down and faded. POP'S MOJO dueled three deep on a short advantage nearing the turn, was joined from the outside by the winner soon after and battled between foes to the head of the stretch then gave way.

ROMAN CANDLE LIGHT was outrun. JUNIOR V. steadied after breaking inward, was away slow and never threatened. NUCKY THOMPSON dueled inside rivals early, was lightly steadied nearing the turn and faltered.
