Footnotes

STAR'S TIZZY FIT , patiently rated within range, dropped to the rail leaving the five eighths pole, was nudged on to keep a forward spot near the far turn, shifted back off the inside and edged closer between runners approaching the quarter pole, responded when shoved on in upper stretch, worked between rivals past the three sixteenths pole, forged to command exiting the eighth pole, was kept alert with one left handed strike then pulled clear with something left. TWO HEARTS IN ONE stalked the pace three wide, moved to challenge after six furlongs, assumed command in upper stretch, was confronted a furlong out, drifted out a bit, gave way grudgingly and saved the place. LEGALLY INCLUDED lagged back while saving ground, came under pressure leaving the far turn, swung five wide for the drive but could only muster up a mild response. KELA'S WISH angled off the rail in early backstretch, moved up into the far turn, loomed four wide when progressing in upper stretch then flattened out. CLEAN HEIR alternated for the lead outside JERSEY ZAPPER through decent early fractions, briefly went clear after six furlongs, was collared into the stretch, gave little fight and tired in the final three sixteenths. JERSEY ZAPPER dueled along the rail for nearly six furlongs then tired.
