### Footnotes

BEN'S CAT stalked the pace under confident handling while two wide on the turn, eased out to the four path when commencing his rally in upper stretch, swept to command in midstretch then drew clear under a hand ride. NIGHT OFFICER lacked speed, hugged the rail through the stretch, slipped through narrow quarters approaching the sixteenth pole and rallied. DISCO ELVIS prompted the pace outside STEADY WARRIOR, bid for the lead approaching the eighth pole and continued gamely. HEROS REWARD lacked speed, was lightly steadied in traffic entering the turn, raced outside foes in the stretch and failed to menace. STEADY WARRIOR sped to the front, set a pressured pace in the two path, abruptly faltered in midstretch then twice switched his leads near the sixteenth pole. GOTTALOVETHEDRAKE, wide entering the stretch, was outrun.
