Footnotes

SILENT SHOT stalked a contested pace three wide, was put to a strong ride leaving the far turn, drifted in nearing the eighth pole while rallying under left handed pressure, moved to command a sixteenth out, dueled outside GALLANT GULCH and held sway while being kept from laying in on that rival. GALLANT GULCH took command at once, set a pressured pace along the inside, drifted out briefly in mid stretch, was overtaken near the sixteenth pole, dueled inside the winner and stayed on well. QUIET SEARCH settled well back, commenced a run inside rivals leaving the three eighths pole, angled out five wide for the drive, continued his progress to the sixteenth pole then hung. BAGOGA lagged far back for six furlongs, entered the stretch three wide, swung out six wide past the three sixteenths pole then finished well for a belated gain. SKIP TO THE NORTH was used four wide around the first turn to reach a pressing position, vied outside GALLANT GULCH to mid stretch, steadied when in close quarters a furlong out and faded. JAZZ SEEKER, three wide between rivals past the seven eighths pole, was rated back soon after, continued losing ground four to five wide and failed to mount a serious rally. DALE'S HONEY stalked the dueling leaders while saving ground and weakened leaving the eighth pole. ZAPPER broke slowly and was outrun. MAX NO DIFFERENCE saved ground and was done after a half mile. An objection by the rider of SKIP TO THE NORTH against the winner for alleged interference in mid stretch was not allowed
