WINDY ANGEL disputed the pace two wide, gained a clear lead on the far turn and weakened in the drive. SAXY LADY lacked speed, raced wide turning for home, failed to menace and passed tired foes. BETRAYED saved ground, disputed the pace and tired through the stretch. TOSSABOUQUET was not a factor. MY SWEET NENANA saved ground, stalked the pace, stopped on the far turn and was eased late.
