BORREGO'S BOY stalked the pace, advanced in the four path on the turn, gained the lead entering the stretch and drew out in the drive. MACHO TASTE dueled two wide, weakened and held the place. HERE COMES MIKEY , wide on the turn, rallied. BIG CODE , in the three path between horses on the turn, chased the pace and gave way. DRAYTON HALL , hard used early, was sent up along the rail to dispute the pace, remained prominent to upper stretch then faded. XYZAB , well off the rail, was outrun. WESTEND WILLY bobbled leaving the starting gate, saved ground on the turn, swung wide in upper stretch and gave way. MO'S BRO , very wide on the turn, was outrun. VANDAS ANGEL trailed.
