CREW , four wide the first turn, advanced in the two path on the far turn, took command in upper stretch, opened a clear lead in midstretch then dug in stubbornly. RAM saved ground, swung to the four path in midstretch then rallied gamely. GREENTREE ROAD saved ground setting a fast pace, lost the lead in upper stretch then faded in the drive. PERFECT LOCH , four wide leaving the far turn, failed to sustain his bid. ALICANTINO saved ground and failed to rally. AMENHOTEP , outrun, swung wide in upper stretch. GRESHAM PALACE , in close quarters leaving the starting gate, steadied on the first turn then was outrun. KLEITON was outrun. DYLAN RAY , well off the rail, chased the pace and faltered entering the stretch.
