Footnotes

SOMONE SAWEET prompted the pace two wide, moved to near even terms past the five sixteenths, dueled three wide into the stretch, gained a slim advantage in upper stretch, bumped with SHADOWOFYOURWINGS near the furlong marker, responded to strong handling and edged ahead late. SO BEST got out soon after the break then was straightened away, stalked the pace three wide into the turn, chased between rivals leaving the three eighths pole, angled out to the five path in the drive and closed between rivals to get the place. WISDOM SEEKER advanced between foes nearing the turn then dropped to the rail soon after, chased the leaders while under a ride, got through along the rail in the lane and continued on willingly though edged for second. SHADOWOFYOURWINGS broke outward and bumped soundly with PLEASANT TIDE, recovered and quickly assumed command, set the early pace along the inside, took pressure around the turn, dueled leaving the quarter pole, came off the inside into the lane, drifted out some and bumped with the winner in mid stretch, continued gamely inside the sixteenth marker then gave way grudgingly in the final strides. BARBARA LEE chased the pace four wide, moved closer approaching the quarter pole, was hung out six wide through the final furlong and finished willingly though outfinished for major shares. PLEASANT TIDE was jostled at the break, moved up between rivals past the five eighths pole, steadied when in close entering the turn then gave way while removed from the rail. MS MILLIE ROBBINS saved ground failing to keep pace and retreated through the drive.
