Footnotes

ART OF THE HUNT , bumped at the break, recovered and moved up into the first turn to prompt the pace three wide, tracked TOUCH THE BIRDS down the backstretch and around the final turn, responded when roused left handed leaving the three sixteenths marker, collared TOUCH THE BIRDS inside the eighth pole then edged away late under steady handling. TOUCH THE BIRDS grabbed command at once, took some early pressure while in the two path, edged clear near the half mile pole, was nudged along around the final turn, was joined past the furlong marker, dueled inside the winner to the sixteenth pole then gave way grudgingly. DECO ROCKS , bumped at the break, lost ground four to five wide stalking the pace, came under a ride around the final turn but lacked a solid response. RING RING , within range between rivals to the half mile pole, gave way. LITCHRALLY bobbled outward into the winner, was straightened away and sent up inside to stalk the pace, raced forwardly while under a ride into the far turn then dropped back leaving the three eighths pole. SO PICKY , bumped and in tight at the break, settled back early, was taken wide near the five eighths pole, failed to respond when called upon around the final turn and weakened.
