BEN'S CAT , in range off of a contested pace, was put to a ride mid turn, circled five wide into the stretch, forged to command leaving the eighth pole, dueled past the sixteenth marker then edged clear under a solid hand ride. SANDBAGIN' LOVER tracked the pace three wide, came four wide for the drive, moved between rivals to challenge nearing the eighth pole and continued on gamely to earn the place. DIGGER prompted the pace two to three wide, moved to a short lead mid turn, was taken on in upper stretch, dueled inside rivals past the furlong marker then gave way grudgingly. NORJAC saved ground failing to keep pace early, angled out for the drive but lacked a solid run. DELAUNAY settled back early, angled out into the turn, made a mild five wide run approaching the stretch then flattened out. MUSIC CITY set a pressured pace inside DIGGER, was overtaken leaving the three eighths pole, continued to dispute the pace into the lane, had his rider lose his whip near the three sixteenths pole and tired.
