Footnotes

TOMORROW'S TALE , patiently rated well back, raced wide around the turn, floated to the five path entering the stretch, closed strongly and drove clear late. **TAP KCLASS** , wide entering the stretch, drifted in a bit in midstretch and rallied. **OUTSMARTING DIXIE** broke slowly, was used hard early, raced wide around the turn, had aim on the lead in midstretch and hung when tiring. **WANNALOTTALOVIN'** prompted the pace outside **DYLAN THE DEPUTY**, gained a short lead in midstretch then weakened. **DYLAN THE DEPUTY** , sent to the front, set the pace along the rail and weakened in the drive. **SHOCKRAHAWN** , in the six path leaving the turn, had a mild, late rally. **RIDGE AMOUR** saved ground and failed to rally. **KENDALLS BEAR** saved ground and was not a factor. **GAELIC PARTNER** lacked speed, rushed up and rear ended **ETUDETOGO** approaching the quarter pole and failed to be a factor. **ETUDETOGO** lacked his usual speed, raced three wide on the turn, gave way midway on the bend then was bumped from behind nearing the quarter pole. **WOODLAND FLUTE** , pinched back leaving the starting gate, raced in the seven path leaving the turn. **ALTERNATING BASS** raced between horses and gave way in upper stretch.
