**Footnotes**

JOEY FRIES was rated back off the pace near the five furlong marker, stalked the dueling leaders while three wide, rallied under strong handling to take command near the sixteenth marker then edged away while taken in hand very late. NO CROSSING LANE dueled two wide, took over leaving the three eighths pole, edged clear in upper stretch, was taken on past the eighth pole and gave way grudgingly. CAESAR'S GOLD , away slowly, lagged back while removed from the rail, circled six wide into the stretch and finished well through the final furlong. OUTQUEST came out at the break brushing GRAND SLAM FRANKIE, lacked speed, was put to a solid ride early turn, angled out four wide and lacked the needed response. BUCKLE DOWN DARLIN saved ground around the turn, eased out in upper stretch, made a mild move between rivals in mid stretch, drifted in towards the rail and flattened out. GRAND SLAM FRANKIE , brushed at the break, recovered and rushed up inside rivals near the five eighths pole and put a head in front, dueled inside NO CROSSING LANE to the head of the lane then gave way approaching the furlong marker. DUKE OF LAUREL , three wide into the lane, failed to menace. MALA MALA CAT was outrun. DADDY'S GABS , bumped at the break, lost ground four wide chasing the pace then tired between rivals in the final eighth. THE JUICE IS LOOSE was outrun while saving ground around the turn. CROSSROAD'S GOLD chased the pace while saving ground, faltered in upper stretch, was eased through the final furlong and returned lame.
