REGAL WARRIOR moved up inside rivals to gain command into the first turn, went clear soon after, opened up leaving the three quarter pole and set a solid pace, was nudged along around the final turn, responded to solid right handed pressure through the lane and held a safe margin. AUCTORITAS , three wide chasing the winner, closed some of the gap while wider in the final furlong and gamely saved the place. BANK OF DAD settled early, angled to the rail nearing the far turn, raced under strong handling into the lane, shifted out some and continued on with interest. ROY L. , unhurried early, angled out four wide into the lane, made progress in the final furlong and shifted out late. BAILEYS BEACH failed to menace. LORD KIPLING , three wide the first turn, lost ground four wide around the far turn and failed to menace. COUNT ON LOU chased the pace off the rail and tired after six furlongs.
