Footnotes

CHI CHI'S PRIDE tracked a contested pace three wide, moved to challenge three furlongs out, dueled under a light hold and gained a slim lead approaching the quarter pole, responded when put to a drive in upper stretch and eagerly widened. SNOWBALL FIGHT pushed outward at the break, was taken to rate off the rail, circled five wide into the stretch, closed willingly once set down and was along to nab the place. BAT CAVE, forwardly placed four wide, edged up to loom a danger mid turn, chased the winner from upper stretch, lugged in near the furlong marker, continued willingly but just lost second. BRAWL pressed the pace two wide and weakened in the final furlong. MONACACY WARRIOR, sluggish early, raced wide and failed to respond. FRUITFUL LABOUR was sent up inside rivals and took command nearing the five eighths pole, set a pressured pace, lost the lead after a half mile, continued pursuit to mid stretch then gave way. OENOMAUS came out at the break, saved ground chasing the pace and faded.
