Footnotes

GRANDILOQUENT , allowed to settle off the pace while saving ground, was shuffled a bit nearing the far turn, angled out and came six wide for the drive, closed steadily under pressure, took command near the sixteenth pole, dueled outside RING RING and prevailed. RING RING , bumped and pinched back at the break, was taken to rate off the rail while within striking distance, gathered momentum inside rivals nearing the stretch, altered out past the three sixteenth pole, moved between horses to challenge inside the furlong marker, dueled inside the winner the final seventy yards and just missed in a game effort. CALOCAGATHIA , bumped and pinched back at the start, lagged back removed from the rail, was asked for run leaving the far turn, circled seven wide for the drive and closed steadily to earn the show. UNBRIDLED PEACE stalked a contested pace three to four wide, edged a bit closer nearing the stretch the lacked a solid finish. SMOOTH LANDING broke outward into RING RING, was straightened but was a bit difficult to settle when pulling her way to contention into the first turn, was able to relax off the contested pace down the backstretch, eased out and move three wide to command entering the lane, kicked clear, was met by challengers soon past the furlong grounds and faded. NEXT LEVEL cleared early and angled in, was joined from the outside nearing the backstretch, dueled inside POLITELYPRECOCIOUS to the head of the stretch then weakened in the final furlong. POLITELYPRECOCIOUS broke inward bumping CALOCAGATHIA, hustled up when corrected and joined NEXT LEVEL after the opening quarter mile, disputed the pace outside that rivals to the top of the lane then surrendered.
