Footnotes

CAM'S REBEL rated forwardly three wide, edged closer when asked leaving the three furlong marker, collared BEAT THE SPREAD approaching the quarter pole, dueled outside that one, assumed command in mid stretch, responded to left handed urging and drew clear. BEAT THE SPREAD set the pace inside, took pressure nearing the lane, dueled inside the winner past to the eighth pole, gave way grudgingly and just held the place. FERRIS FACE , forced out at the start, was corrected and settled off the pace while removed from the inside, circled six wide into the stretch and rallied. CHRIS'S SYMPHONY bore out at the break, was straightened and chased four wide, made progress into the lane then flattened out in the final furlong. THORNMARK , taken to rate early, came four wide for the drive, shifted in and went evenly. MORNING LIGHT chased the pace while saving ground, dropped back near the quarter pole, angle out and came up empty. DOUBLE DANCER forced the pace two wide and tired. SPLASH OF GIN , off slowly when rank at the break, saved ground and was outrun.
