Footnotes

FIRST WHIPPOORWILL , wide around the far turn, swept to command approaching the eighth pole and was under rousing to the wire. MIMI'S SHOES , five wide the far turn, rallied. JERSEY RAMBLER , wide the first turn, angled to the rail mid way on the far turn, was lightly steadied in narrow quarters in midstretch and rallied late. CHARMED BY DANGER stalked the pace outside FEISTY ANGELINA, challenged for the lead entering the stretch and weakened late. LEXINGTON PEARL , steadied in tight quarters entering the first turn, was four wide the far turn, angled out in mid stretch and passed tired rivals. MISTRESS QUICKLY , wide the first turn, rushed up outside horses entering the backstretch, was three wide the far turn and tired in the stretch. CAROLINA MOONDANCE , steadied when pinched back soon after the break, raced inside horses in the stretch and finished willingly. FEISTY ANGELINA set the pace slightly off the rail and gave way in mid stretch. STOLEN DANCE bore out entering the first turn, was prominent off the rail and gave way in

upper stretch. MISTY'S SONG , steadied when rank the first turn, gave way. FIREY ROCKETTE saved ground and stopped.
