Footnotes

DR. SKIP worked between horses on the far turn, angled outside in upper stretch, gained the lead inside the eighth pole and was kept under urging. SEE TOBE lacked speed, worked between horses in the stretch and rallied gamely. GOGOLEGO , outrun to the far turn, swung to the seven path in upper stretch and closed late. SILBER STERN , studdish in the post parade, chased the pace outside PENDULUM gained a short lead in upper stretch and weakened the final furlong. AGONISTIC , swung very wide entering the stretch, failed to threaten. PENDULUM sprinted clear early, set the pace near the rail and weakened. ORCHESTRA LEADER saved ground and weakened. POLLARDS IMAGE lacked speed, was inside horses in the stretch and steadied lacking room approaching the sixteenth pole. SINGIN THE BLUES raced inside horses and was steadied in tight quarters near the sixteenth pole. RABBIT TRACKS lost ground on the turns and gave way. WOODBURNER , wide, was outrun.
