SERELA was unhurried early, moved closer along the inside after six furlongs, rallied between rivals in midstretch, gained a short lead near the sixteenth pole and dug in gamely under stiff pressure to prevail. WEEKEND KAPER was well placed along the inside in early backstretch, angled off the rail leaving the three furlong marker, ranged up four wide into the lane, lodged a bid in midstretch, had her rider lose his whip near the sixteenth pole then continued gamely to just miss. BROOMESSE stalked a contested pace three wide, moved closer midway on the final turn, took command in upper stretch, dueled late, battled tenaciously between rivals but just wasn't good enough. LA BELLE DANSE disputed the pace along the inside and weakened near the sixteenth marker. TAX AFFAIR set a pressured pace in the two path, was headed near the quarter pole and faltered. COMPLETE NUMBER lost ground three wide and surrendered after six furlongs.
