R U SMOKIN , bumped at the break, pulled his way to contention nearing the half mile marker, tracked the dueling leaders past the three eighths pole, was guided three wide, moved to command in upper stretch, edged clear under right handed pressure and held firm. RECKLESS RUNNER rushed up inside soon after the break, dueled through quick fractions and stayed on well. ITALIAN MAMBO , four wide, drifted out entering the lane brushing with TUSCANY'S EXPRESS, was corrected and closed willingly. TUSCANY'S EXPRESS , six wide into the lane, was brushed and failed to rally. MR. RECORD MAN , in range along the rail off the dueling leaders, failed to respond. SQUISH failed to menace. OUR BAILIWICK dueled two wide through solid fractions, held a short lead into the lane then faltered approaching the furlong pole. SALADIN , bumped at the break, lagged back, came four wide for the drive and lacked a rally. JADED SILVER was not a threat. ROSEMONT DRIVE was in a bit tight nearing the turn. FLIPFLOPSANDSOCKS was fractious in the gate.
