FOR THREE-YEAR-OLDS AND UPWARD. By subscription of \$100 each which should accompany the nomination, \$500 to pass the entry box, \$500 additional to start, with \$75,000 Guaranteed, and an additional \$75,000 from the Breeders' Cup Fund for Cup nominees only. The Host Association's added monies to be divided, 60% of all monies to the winner, 20% to second, 11% to third, 6% to fourth and 3% to fifth. Footnotes

THE LADY'S GROOM broke on top, dueled inside of UNFORGETTABLE MAX from the first turn to the sixteenth marker then edged clear under constant right handed pressure. UNFORGETTABLE MAX moved up outside to join the winner into the first turn, dueled and gave way grudgingly in the final seventy yards. IRISH COLONY, unhurried early while saving ground, gained ground along the rail leaving the three furlong marker, angled out three wide entering the stretch, loomed boldly but was simply no match for the top pair. JORGIE STOVER lost ground three wide, prompted the pace into the far turn then gradually faded from there. YOUR BLUFFING was allowed to settle well off the leaders, saved ground under urging into the lane but failed to generate much of a response. MY KIND OF TOWN saved ground into the stretch and tired. MY REQUEST, two wide, was perfectly placed off the dueling leaders, was called on for run entering the far turn and faltered.
