RAM chased the pace outside ARMI BASE, overtook that one in upper stretch then drew off under energetic urging. HARD ROCK DELITE drifted out leaving the starting gate, chased the pace three wide on the turn, drifted out in upper stretch and finished gamely. BRAVACCIO drifted out leaving the starting gate, raced between horses on the turn then rallied outside foes late. OUR BAILIWICK, in hand behind horses near the three eighths pole, swung to the six path in midstretch and rallied mildly. SUPERSTRUCTURE, no factor, was extremely wide on the turn. STORM CATLILLY, very wide on the turn, weakened. ONE FRENCH KISS, steadied in close quarters along the rail near the five eighths pole, gave way. ARMI BASE saved ground, set a pressured pace and gave way. MONTY'S APPEAL, pinched back leaving the starting gate, raced wide leaving the turn.
