CHEROKEE'S BOY quickly went clear, set the pace along the inside while unchallenged, was set down in upper stretch, raced on his left lead until late and held sway under a drive. PENOBSCOT BAY was rated back off of the winner entering the first turn, stalked the pace two wide, was put to strong urging around the final turn, drifted out from left handed pressure in mid stretch then closed some once straightened. HIGH WATERMARK , outrun early, saved ground into the lane and outfinished the others. GIMMEAWINK was taken to rate, angled out three wide into the backstretch, continued wide under urging into the lane and came up empty. GANG lost ground four wide, moved up some into the far turn but lacked much from there. SEATTLE SURPRISE raced off the rail and failed to make an impact.
