BURST AWAY took pressure setting the pace in the two path, shook clear leaving the five sixteenths marker, widened a bit in upper stretch, responded to solid right handed encouragement and held firm. MEREDITH'S STAR broke a tad slow then quickly reached contention, stalked the pace three wide, was put to a drive mid turn, finished gamely through the final three sixteenths and closed the gap in a nice debut. GAGNE was taken to rate behind a wall of horses near the three eighths pole, angled four wide entering the stretch but could only muster a mild response. MONSTER SLEEPING stumbled badly at the break, pulled her way to reach contention between foes after a quarter mile, was put to heavy pressure mid turn continuing between rivals, failed to respond and faded. ALERT CAT lost ground four wide giving chase and failed to rally. DREAM DOER pressed the pace three wide outside the winner, held well to the head of the stretch then weakened. INDEED saved ground chasing the pace and tired before going a half mile.
