HUNKA HUNKA LORI Z went to a clear lead into the first turn, set the pace in the two path, edged away some into the lane, drifted in a bit near the three sixteenths marker then was all out to hold off GUILLOTINE. GUILLOTINE saved ground, moved closer into the far turn, angled out for the drive, closed gamely and just missed. RICO ENDS WELL was angled off the rail into the first turn, prompted the pace three wide, was pushed along three furlongs out and gradually faded from the quarter pole. MEDIA ACCESS raced three wide between rivals around the clubhouse turn and dropped back after six furlongs. LADY CORDELIA lost ground four wide and weakened nearing the lane. IN THE FRONT ROW raced between rivals early and faltered.
