SHINE AGAIN prompted the pace well in hand while two to three wide, took over four and a half furlongs out, went clear around the final turn and held sway under a drive. UNBRIDLED LADY was taken to rate along the inside, angled out leaving three furlong marker, circled five wide into the lane and closed gamely to earn the place in the final yards. CASE OF THE BLUES settled off the rail, moved up three wide nearing the quarter pole, continued her run to the eighth pole then flattened out and was edged for the place. TOOKIN DOWN saved ground throughout and lacked a solid closing response. SILENT VALAY went clear early, set a pressured pace while racing slightly off the inside, chased the winner into the stretch then tired. HERE'S GOLD raced off the rail most of the way and tired. PROUD OWNER raced off the rail and tired.
