DELVIN'S A HATER came away running from the inside, was patiently handled and allowed to draft back a bit, advanced within himself mid turn and took aim on the battling leaders, was guided out three wide after a half mile, forged to command in upper stretch, lugged in a bit going clear then widened under a drive. FAST STACK dueled two wide, took over nearing the quarter pole, was engaged from the outside soon after, gave way grudgingly and saved the place. SIR COTTON, outrun early while saving some ground, angled out entering the stretch, bulled his way between rivals in mid stretch bumping OH WHAT A KNIGHT then kept on with interest. GRAND SAM saved ground under nice rating, eased out progressing in upper stretch, shifted back in for the final furlong but lacked the needed response. FIRST MINISTER lagged back, circled very wide into the lane, was soundly bumped in mid stretch and finished willingly. YUKON SPECIAL chased the early pace, steadied between rivals near the half mile marker, regrouped and made a bit of progress between foes in mid stretch then flattened out. YIELD AT THE BULL settled off the pace, came three to four wide for the drive and offered up a belated kick. MR. SNEAKERS chased the pace, came four wide for the drive and gave way. OH WHAT A KNIGHT, bumped at the break, lost ground four to five wide, was turned sideways by SIR COTTON in mid stretch and flattened out. OCALA SON bobbled at the break, rushed up between runners to take command,

set a pressured pace towards the inside, lost command past the five sixteenths pole then faltered in upper stretch. THIS ONES FOR NINA came in at the break and bumped with OH WHAT A KNIGHT. CHASING LOVE broke in a tangle and failed to recover.
