KIPPERS N' EGGS , under a strangle hold three to four wide just off the early pace, relaxed a bit into the far turn, cruised past the dueling leaders after six furlongs, eagerly widened in upper stretch and was alert to the wire. RISKY RED prompted the pace outside WORTHY WAGER, moved to engage in early backstretch, gained a short lead after a half mile, dueled to the five sixteenths marker, gave willing chase from there but was simply overmatched. WORTHY WAGER cleared early, set the pace towards the rail dueled inside RISKY RED from the half mile marker to mid turn then faded in the drive. ALL BORN SINNERS , removed from the rail, was not a factor. WHATDOYOUSEE passed tiring rivals. HIDEAWAY MOON nearly flipped when unruly in the gate, stalked the early pace and tired. SILENT SHOT , in a bit close nearing the first turn, saved ground and retreated.
