BROAD SOUND saved ground, swung out inside the three sixteenths pole, her rider briefly lost his left rein in midstretch, regained control and drove clear. RIDE THE WILD WIND dueled along the rail and weakened. HUNCA MUNCA disputed the pace two wide and gave way. FLASHY THREE (GB) stalked the pace, came three wide into the stretch and gave way. STAND ALONE lacked speed, raced inside horses and passed tired ones. HONOR STUDENT, rank after hitting the inside of her starting gate stall, raced wide entering the stretch and failed to rally. TOWNLINE was no factor. WHITE GOLD, three wide on the turns, gave way.
