LONGLEY dueled two wide virtually every step of the way and narrowly prevailed in an extended drive. LEAGLENOTE dueled inside of the winner and just missed in a sharp effort. CAME LOW settled in mid pack, saved ground from the far turn to the wire and rallied mildly. SPECIAL UNION had some belated action off the rail. TOUGH STUFF , off the rail down the backstretch, chased the pace and faded. BETWITHBOTHHANDS failed to menace. BEAN , off the rail, was urged along around the final turn and weakened.
