Footnotes

CALAWAY saved ground around the turn, swung to the four path in midstretch, closed steadily and was along in time. COLONEL GRAND saved ground disputing the pace, came out entering the stretch and just missed in a game effort after his rider dropped his whip in midstretch. AFTERNOON JAZZ broke slowly, angled to the rail leaving the turn, chased the pace, flattened out and was steadied late. FLY WITH RAVENS prompted the pace outside COLONEL GRAND and gave way in upper stretch. PEACEFUL RULER, wide on the turn and through the stretch, was not a factor. INNER PASSION was in tight quarters along the rail near the half mile pole. CENTER HARBOR was outrun. JUSTKEEPCOMINGBACK saved ground around the turn, failed to be a factor and unseated his rider when veering in to avoid the fallen horse inside the sixteenth pole. QUIET STEPS circled the turn, challenged for the lead entering the stretch, dueled, lugged in near the eighth pole and broke down near the sixteenth pole.
