FRIENDSLIKETHESE lacked speed, swung wide in upper stretch and closed late. GENERALISSIMO set the pace, raced along the rail and weakened. PERNAMBUCO advanced on the far turn and weakened in the drive. ROBS WAY was outrun. MICHAELS VOW was outrun. YARROW'S CAT dropped back.
