Footnotes

CROWN POLIS was guided out three wide entering the first turn and eagerly made his way up to a tracking spot, cruised to command leaving the three eighths pole, opened a clear lead after six furlongs, responded when set down in upper stretch, moved well clear in mid stretch and drifted out some late under a drive. IRON POST, taken four wide early, rated along down the backstretch, made a sharp four wide move nearing the quarter pole to loom, kept on willingly but simply was no match. SELF DESTRUCT, three to four wide while forwardly placed, gained ground leaving the far turn, gave chase into the stretch and just edged PIAMENTO for the show. PIAMENTO rated in the two path inside rivals, eased out and was sent between runners approaching the stretch, failed to seriously kick on and was edged for the show. BAKU drafted towards the inside in early backstretch, stalked the pace, came under a hard ride past the three eighths pole, altered out near the quarter pole, failed to kick on and weakened. DON'T SCIP A CHECK cleared early, set a rated pace off the rail, gave no resistance when collared and faltered.
