Footnotes

DISCO DANDY sped to the front and drew out the final furlong under energetic urging. BHUTAN , two wide, chased the winner, had aim on the lead in midstretch then gave way. AMERI HEMLOCK saved ground around the turn and weakened. BUDGET BUSTER , three wide on the turn, weakened. FOXS UPTOWN BOY passed tired ones. HOUND passed tired rivals. MOVIN' OUT broke through the starting gate before the race, saved ground on the turn and gave way. NO CROSSING LANE lacked speed, raced wide and failed to be a factor. WOODEN INDIAN was outrun. FINAL AUTHORITY , pinched back soon after the break, raced wide around the turn and was outrun.
